

Audio Recording Course Syllabus

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Course Description:

In this course, students will study modern recording techniques and some live audio information. Students will learn basic functions of Pro Tools and create recordings. They will also learn editing skills as well as how and when to use plug-ins. This class is about 70% hands on and 30% book work. This class requires extensive work with computers.

USB drives are not allowed, but it is highly recommended to create an online storage account for free using Dropbox or Google Drive.
