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Course Description:

This audio course will focus on audio provided for live events like concerts, conferences, and installations. Students will learn about planning, set up and operation of live audio equipment for these events. Classroom instruction will consist of the standards below. Experience will be gained by operating as a full functioning installation and audio provider. The community will hire the class to provide support for events. This course will include heavy lifting, loud noise levels and physical activity. Please pay close attention to materials for class.

Blue or black jeans will also need to be worn when we operate systems out in the community. If it is extremely hot, shorts that meet the school dress code will be fine.
